

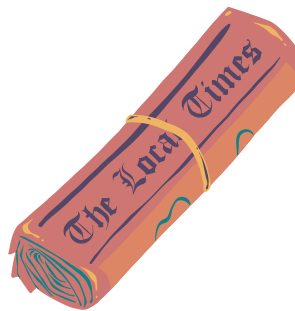

What is The British Newspaper Archive?

The British Newspaper Archive is a database that houses a vast collection of historical British newspapers with fully-searchable pages. It is the most comprehensive database of its kind and contains most newspapers published in Britain from 1800. You can search for specific content with the powerful 'advanced search' feature, or browse articles by date, country, region, etc.

What can I use it for?

You can use The British Newspaper Archive to find any sort of information that you would usually look for in hardcopy papers—articles, obituaries, announcements and advertisements. However, instead of spending hours hunched over your desk with physical copies, you can search millions of articles in seconds with just a few strokes of your keyboard!
