What is Overdrive/Libby?

Libby is an app created by Overdrive that gives library members access to read thousands of eBook and eAudiobook titles as well as hundreds of magazines, right from their phone or tablet. Sign in with your library card and PIN to start borrowing. Members can borrow up to 20 eBooks, eAudiobooks or eMagazines for 21 days. Borrowers can search through 'most popular', 'newly added' or browse favourites genres, such as historical fiction, true crime and children's books.

What can I use it for?

Libby can be used for reading and listening to a large range of eBooks, eAudiobooks, and eMagazines right from your device. All you need is the Libby app (available for Apple, Android and Windows devices) and your Hawkesbury library card. To get started, download the app and enter your library card details for free access. To read books from your internet browser, go to the following web address:
