- Refer to the architecture concept design package for more detail on the building design proposal






B. Civic forecourt

- Visual connections to the building and to the park



A. Existing playground


• Tie path network into existing playground and incorporate into park upgrades

- Planting and trees to create more shade and to soften the landscape









C. Nature play

- Sculpture and interpretation







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




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

A. Active youth space

- A space that supports physical activity, including for teenage girls
- Passive surveillance, connectivity and accessibility of the youth space
- A multi-programmed space to cater for a range of users at different times of the day including for weekend sport
- Clear connections to different site programs including new building and playing fields
- An 'active edge' including seating elements
- Consider incorporating art in paving








B. Inclusive Hang-out Space

- Create a social hang-out space this will create a strong sense of spatial ownership
- Space that offers both active use and social interaction
- Design a component of physical space that encourages and welcomes female dominated activities
- Provide a flexible space that is not strictly defined and which can be used for different activities
- Provided defined space with aspect views, safety and surveillance

- A learn to ride track as potential use near the Family Centre for the wider community
- Consider providing entry gates and fence to ensure safety to protect users from the road and car park
- Incorporate appropriate planting to soften the landscape and as barrier planting between the tracks and the car park and road








B & C. Flexible lawn space & sensory gardens

- Both active and quiet spaces for all ages













A: Carpark, parklands & landscape buffer

- Native trees & planting for shading and to create a landscape buffer to the park edges
- A car park with planting buffer
- Consider permeable pavement to reduce runoff and increase infiltration of water into the ground
- Integrated storm water treatment into the landscape
- Consider vegetated swales to collect, direct and filter surface run off
- Provide multi-use lawn spaces for picnics, sports & play







B. Path network, seating and exercise stations

- A loop track around the park
- Seating along the pathways
- Exercise stations along the loop track
- Accessible pathways throughout the park and at entries


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Scope of works A

- Landscaping works, including new pathways, seating, lawn, and native vegetation



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




Scope of works D
